Business Administration career paths include accountant or auditor, appraiser or assessor of real estate, budget analyst, claims adjuster, appraisers or examiners, compensation and benefit analysts, cost estimators, financial analyst and examiners, fundraisers, operations analyst, management trainee, human resource specialists, insurance underwriters, loan officers, supply chain, management analysts, market research analysts, purchasing managers and buyers, tax examiners and collectors, and training and development specialists. In addition, the degree provides an excellent avenue to transfer credits to a four-year institution to achieve a bachelor's degree.
